

Electrolux Young Chef 2010 Terms & Conditions



HOW TO ENTER

To enter, eligible entrants must complete the online or hard copy application forms and submit it with the requested documents as outlined on the application form and below via the website www.appetiteforexcellence.com

Applications for Electrolux Young Chef 2010 should additionally include: a copy of Certificate III in Hospitality – Commercial Cookery qualification **or** a written and signed reference from your current employer; copy of citizenship or proof of permanent residency; copy of Australian driver's licence (where held); an original seasonal winter menu designed and created by the entrant including photos; and, payment of the \$45.00 application fee. Only one entry is permitted per person. All applications will be referenced checked to confirm the work history is correct.

Electrolux Young Chef applicants will be placed in the following state groups; NSW/ACT combined, VIC, WA, SA, TAS, QLD, and, NT. Each state group's applications will be assessed by an appointed judge from the state judging panel, each of whom will select the two to three best applicants from the state that they judge to be the best two to three finalists for that state.

The finalists (two to three per state) will each win the chance to compete in the national final on Monday 7th June 2010. The Electrolux Young Chef 2010 finalists will each have one hour to prepare one (1) course for four (4) people from their application menu. Each finalist will be told the day prior which recipe they will be presenting. After the allotted time period of 1 hour, each finalist will present their dishes to the national finalist judges and then spend 15 minutes talking to the judges and answering questions posed by the judges. The seven finalists with the highest number of points at the conclusion of the Electrolux Young Chef national final will be the seven national finalists from around Australia. All of the Electrolux Young Chef finalists may be required to participate in events and/or prizes on the evening of Monday 07th June and during the day on Tuesday 8th June 2010 in Sydney. During this time the Electrolux Young Chef, Electrolux Young Waiter and Electrolux Young Restaurateur 2010 national finalists will be announced.

On Tuesday 08th June 2010, the Electrolux Young Chef Finalists and National Finalists will be required to participate in a professional portrait photo session. As part of their involvement in the program, they will participate in a comprehensive and informative coffee session held at the Allpress Roastery. This 1hr class covers the raw material from growing and harvesting through to production and blending. It will also include a cupping session (coffee tasting) of single origins and blends from coffee growing countries around the globe.

Each national finalist will each win a trip to visit one of Australia's leading food and wine regions. The national finalists will also win the chance to compete in the final judging and selection in Sydney on Monday 07th July 2010. The Electrolux Young Chef 2010 national finalists will each have three hours to prepare a three (3) course menu for four (4) people consisting of an entrée, main course, and, dessert. All three courses will be created from a mystery selection of ingredients. After the allotted time period of 3 hours, each national finalist will present their dishes to the judging panel and then spend 15–20 minutes talking to the judges and answering questions posed by the judges. The national finalist with the highest number of points at the conclusion of the Electrolux Young Chef final selection will be the 2010 winner. A winner must be chosen. The national finalists will then attend the Electrolux Appetite for Excellence awards presentation event in Sydney on Monday 09th August 2010 where the Electrolux Young Chef, Electrolux Young Waiter, and Electrolux Young Restaurateur 2010 winners will be announced.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Information on how to enter and prizes forms part of these conditions of entry.
2. Entry to Electrolux Young Chef 2010 is only open to persons aged between 18 and 30 years who are; a) currently working professionally within the restaurant or catering industry in Australia; b) have completed and hold the nationally recognized qualification of Certificate III in Hospitality – Commercial Cookery, or have worked full time as a chef for a minimum of three years and have provided a written and signed letter of reference by their current employer; c) are an Australian citizen or permanent resident; and, d) are aged 30 or younger on Tuesday 10th August 2010.
3. Employees, directors and management of the Promoter, associated companies and agencies and the immediate family members of these people, are ineligible to enter.
4. Promotion commences 01.02.10. Entries close at 17:00 AEST on 16.04.10. Only eligible entrants with correctly completed application forms will be accepted. This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner. Each entry will be individually judged based on the merit criteria set out in these conditions of entry and ancillary promotional material. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
5. By entering the competition, each Electrolux Young Chef entrant warrants that the recipe and photograph(s) of the meal created and submitted by that entrant are original and were created by the entrant, that the entrant owns copyright in the recipe (insofar as any copyright exists) and photograph(s) submitted and that the recipe and photograph(s) do not infringe the rights of any third party. The entrant agrees to indemnify the Promoter against all claims and costs by third parties arising from a breach of the warranty set out in this condition. Photograph(s) not taken by the entrant or in which the entrant does not own copyright and recipes that are not the original work of the entrant (either in design or creation), are not eligible for entry, and will be invalid.
6. Only one entry per person is permitted.

7. Applicants for Electrolux Young Chef will be placed in the following state groups; NSW/ACT combined, VIC, WA, SA, TAS, QLD and NT. Each state group's applications will be assessed by a state judge from the state representative panel who will create a shortlist of state group finalists from which two to three will be selected from each state group to be provisional finalists. Finalists will then enter a national final competition held in Sydney where a judging panel combined of state judge(s) and national judge(s) will select seven (7) national finalists from around Australia. More than one national finalist can come from one state. Young Chef of the Year Pty Ltd will provide flights from the capital city of the state that the selected finalists are from. Finalists will need to organize their own transfers to and from their home state city airport. Young Chef of the Year Pty Ltd will provide shared accommodation to finalist selected to take part in the national finals held in Sydney for the time that they are required to participate in the competition.
8. It is a condition of entry that the provisional national finalist's agree to attend a trip as specified in condition 12. The trip culminates in the final judging and selection in Sydney on Monday 05th July 2010. Each national finalist will also be required to attend the Electrolux Appetite for Excellence 2010 awards presentation event in Sydney, which will be held on Monday 09th August 2010. In addition to the prize as specified in condition 12, the Promoter will provide all finalists with accommodation and transport to the relevant events which they are required to attend. Spending money, meals other than breakfast, insurance, transport to and from departure point, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the finalist.
9. It is a further condition of entry that the 2010 Electrolux Young Chef national winner is available to attend and participate in a reader event dinner on Tuesday 10th August and Wednesday 11th August 2010. In addition the 2010 national winner must be available to attend the S.Pellegrino Cooking Cup in Venice in June/July 2011. The Promoter will provide all finalists with accommodation and transport to the relevant events which they are required to attend if they are outside of their home state. Spending money, meals other than breakfast, insurance, transport to and from departure point, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the winner.
10. The Promoter will contact each provisional young chef finalist and confirm that they wish to continue in this competition and can participate in the events specified in clause 11, 12, 13 and 14. In the event that the provisional young chef national finalist does not agree to continue in the competition and participate in these events then their entry will be declared void and will not proceed any further in the competition and will also not receive any prize. The Promoter will then offer the prize to another entrant. Upon confirmation by the provisional national finalist that they wish to participate further in the competition they will be declared a national finalist.
11. Finalists: Each young chef finalist who is not selected as a national finalist will have the opportunity to partake in a one day skills workshop prize in their state of residence. Designed to be taken as a group with young waiters and young restaurateurs, it will be held in August or September 2010 with the exact date to be confirmed. The trip will be determined at least 4 weeks in advance with young chefs notified of the date.
12. National Finalists: Each young chef national finalist will receive an award certificate and a prize trip including return economy airfares from the winner's nearest capital city to the trip destination and then Sydney, meals and accommodation. All national finalists must be available to travel on Sunday 27th June 2010 and the trip will culminate in Sydney on the day of Sunday 04th July 2010. The 2010 trip destination is NSW, from Byron to Sydney. The trip and itinerary is subject to change at any time. The young chef national finalists will spend Sunday 04th July 2010 attending partners, media, and photography commitments in Sydney before being briefed on the final selection & judging to be held on Monday 05th July 2010. National finalists will travel home on either the evening of Monday 05th July 2010 or during the day on Tuesday 06th July 2010. Additional spending money, taxes, insurance, transport to and from departure point, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the finalist. Prize must be taken at the specified dates and is subject to booking and flight availability.
13. National Winner: The best Electrolux Young Chef entrant in the final, as determined by the judges at the final judging and selection, will win the prize of a trip overseas including return economy airfares from Sydney to the point of destination as determined by Young Chef of the Year Pty Ltd in conjunction with Qantas (return ticket is valid for 12 months); AUD\$3,000.00 cash to assist with overseas travel & work experience expenses; return economy airfares from London to Venice to represent Australia in the S. Pellegrino Venice Cup Challenge in June/July 2011; 2 nights accommodation in Venice; and, two weeks work experience at a leading overseas restaurant. Additional spending money, accommodation other than that provided; meals, taxes, insurance, passports, visas, transport to and from departure points, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the winner. Prize must be taken by July 1st 2011 and is subject to booking and flight availability.

National Runner-Up: The next best Electrolux Young Chef entrant, as determined by the judges at the final judging, will receive a certificate; and, one (1) weeks work experience in a renowned Australian restaurant. Flights & accommodation if required will be provided. Additional spending money, accommodation other than that provided; meals, taxes, insurance, transport to and from departure points, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the Runner-Up
15. Recognition Award: The young chef that the judges determine to be deserving of supportive recognition will receive a certificate.
16. The Judges will determine a National Winner, a National Runner-Up and a recipient of the Recognition Award for the Electrolux Young Chef category.

It is also a condition of entry that Electrolux Young chef finalists, national finalists and/or, winners will be required to appear in an ambassadorial role for four (4) events up until August 2011. Flights, accommodation, and transfers will be provided by The Promoter, if held out of the state finalist or winner's home state.
18. All cash prizes will be awarded in the form of a cheque.
