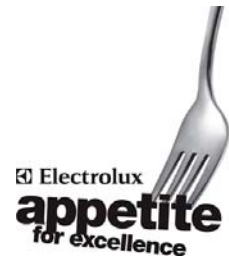


Electrolux Young Chef 2010 Terms & Conditions



HOW TO ENTER

To enter, eligible entrants must complete the online or hard copy application forms and submit it with the requested documents as outlined on the application form and below via the website www.appetiteforexcellence.com

Applications for Electrolux Young Restaurateur 2010 should additionally include: your CV; your liquor licence; copy of a current review; copy of citizenship or proof of permanent residency; copy of Australian driver's licence (where held); and, payment of the \$45.00 application fee. Only one entry is permitted per person.

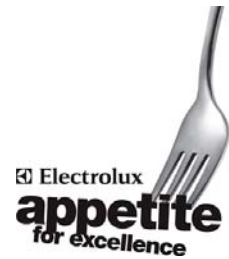
Electrolux Young Restaurateur applications will be assessed by the appointed judging panel, who will select the three to four best applicants that they judge to be the best three finalists from around Australia.

Each young restaurateur finalist will each win a trip to visit one of Australia's leading food and wine regions. The finalists will also win the chance to attend an interview with the Electrolux Young Restaurateur judging panel in Sydney on Monday 09th August 2010 to determine the Electrolux Young Restaurateur for 2010. The finalist with the highest number of points at the conclusion of the Electrolux Young Restaurateur national interviews will be the 2010 winner. The finalists will then attend the Electrolux Appetite for Excellence awards presentation event in Sydney on Monday 09th August 2010 where the Electrolux Young Chef, Electrolux Young Waiter, and Electrolux Young Restaurateur 2010 winners will be announced.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Information on how to enter and prizes forms part of these conditions of entry.
2. Entry to Electrolux Young Restaurateur 2010 is only open to persons aged between 18 and 35 years who; a) own a restaurant in Australia for 2 years or more; b) whose business is licenced; c) are an Australian citizen or permanent resident; and, d) are aged 35 or younger on Tuesday 10th August 2010.
3. Restaurateurs whose business does not hold a liquor licence cannot apply. Employees, directors and management of the Promoter, associated companies and agencies and the immediate family members of these people, are ineligible to enter.
4. Promotion commences 01.02.10. Entries close at 17:00 AEST on 16.04.10. Only eligible entrants with correctly completed application forms will be accepted. This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner. Each entry will be individually judged based on the merit criteria set out in these conditions of entry and ancillary promotional material. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
5. By entering the competition, each Electrolux Young Restaurateur entrant warrants that the information submitted by that entrant is original and written by the entrant and any reviews submitted have been written and published in a magazine, newspaper or on internet by an authorised food writer other than the young restaurateur, their family, or employees.
6. Only one entry per person is permitted.
7. Applicants for Electrolux Young Restaurateur will be assessed on a nationwide basis with three finalists chosen from Australia to go forward for an interview to determine the national winner.
8. Whilst it is not a condition of entry that the provisional finalist's agree to attend a trip as specified in condition 11, it would be preferred that they do attend. At the culmination of the trip each of the finalists will return to their home state. The Promoter will provide all finalists with accommodation and transport to the relevant events which they are required to attend. Spending money, meals other than breakfast, insurance, transport to and from departure point, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the finalist.
9. It is a further condition of entry that the 2010 Electrolux Young Restaurateur national winner is available to attend The S.Pellegrino World's 50 Best Restaurants in London in 2011, date, and month to be confirmed. The Promoter and or its partners will provide the winner with accommodation and flights to attend this event. Spending money, meals other than breakfast, insurance, transport to and from departure point, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the winner.
10. The Promoter will contact each provisional young restaurateur national finalist and confirm that they wish to continue in this competition and can participate in the events specified in clause 11, 12 and 14. In the event that the provisional young restaurateur finalist does not agree to continue in the competition and participate in these events then their entry will be declared void and will not proceed any further in the competition and will also not receive any prize. The Promoter will then offer the prize to another entrant. Upon confirmation by the provisional national finalist that they wish to participate further in the competition they will be declared a national finalist.
11. National Finalists: Each young restaurateur national finalist will receive an award certificate; will join some of Electrolux Appetite for Excellence's judges for lunch; and, has the opportunity to participate in a prize trip including return economy airfares from the national finalist nearest capital city to the trip destination, meals and accommodation. All national finalists must be available to travel on Sunday 27th June 2010 returning to their home state on the day of Sunday 04th July 2010. The 2010 trip destination is NSW, from Byron to Sydney. The trip and itinerary is subject to change at any time. Additional spending money, taxes, insurance, transport to and from departure point, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the finalist. Prize must be taken at the specified dates and is subject to booking and flight availability.

12. National Winners: The best Electrolux Young Restaurateur, as determined by the judges at the national final, will win the prize of a trip to London including return economy airfares from Sydney to London Heathrow to attend The S.Pellegrino World's 50 Best Restaurants" Gala presentation event in London in 2011, date and month to be confirmed as a guest of S.Pellegrino; AUD\$8,000.00 cash prize to invest in their business under the guidance of a mentor. Additional spending money, accommodation other than that provided; meals, taxes, insurance, passports, visas, transport to and from departure points, transfers and all other ancillary costs are not included and are the responsibility of the winner. Prize must be taken on the date as specified by S.Pellegrino and is subject to booking and flight availability.
13. National Runner-Up: The next best Electrolux Young Restaurateur entrant, as determined by the judges at the national final, will receive a certificate.
14. The Judges will determine a National Winner, and a National Runner-Up and for the Electrolux Young Restaurateur category.
15. It is also a condition of entry that Electrolux Young Restaurateur national finalists, and/or, winners will be required to appear in an ambassadorial role for four (4) events on behalf of Electrolux Appetite for Excellence. Flights, accommodation and transfers will be provided by The Promoter where required.
16. All cash prizes will be awarded in the form of a cheque.
17. Prizes, or any unused portion of a prize, are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash. No responsibility is accepted for any variation in the prize package or value of the prize package.
